MOTION FOR ISSUANCE OF FINAL ORDER

On March 5, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”), Region 1, filed an Amended Complaint against Tim’s Express Decks and Odd Jobs, LLC (“Respondent”), alleging that Respondent violated Sections 15 and 409 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (“TSCA”), 15 U.S.C. §§ 2614 and 2689, the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 (“the Act”), 42 U.S.C. § 4851 *et seq.*, and the federal regulations promulgated thereunder, entitled “Residential Property Renovation,” as set forth at 40 C.F.R. Part 745, Subpart E (the “Renovation, Repair, and Painting Rule” or “RRP Rule”). The Amended Complaint sought a penalty of \$972.

EPA’s Consolidated Rules of Practice, codified at 40 C.F.R. part 22, govern this administrative enforcement proceeding. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.18(a), a respondent may opt for a quick resolution of an enforcement proceeding at any time by paying the penalty proposed in the complaint. *See* 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.18(a)(1) and (2). The rules further provide that upon payment of the full penalty, the Regional Judicial Officer must issue a final order. 40 C.F.R. § 22.18(a)(3).

On March 27, 2021, Respondent opted for a quick resolution of the above-captioned matter by paying the penalty proposed in the Amended Complaint of \$972. (*See* attached Exhibit.) EPA accordingly moves for the issuance of an order under 40 C.F.R. §22.18(a)(3) finding that Respondent has paid the full penalty proposed in the Amended Complaint, thereby resolving the above-captioned matter.

In support of its Motion, EPA submits the attached Exhibit reflecting confirmation of payment and a proposed Final Order.
