

ORDER EXTENDING ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Alternative Dispute Resolution process expired on January 28, 2008, with no settlement having been reached. Although Complainant has agreed to a two week extension of ADR to allow Respondent to supply documentation to support an inability to pay claim, Respondent has indicated that, because his accountants are busy with tax matters, it will require six to eight weeks to furnish the required documentation. Additionally, Respondent has retained counsel who has requested additional time to assess the situation and appropriately advise his client. Accordingly, the ADR process is extended for 30 days or until February 27, 2008.
