Phase II Interim Report Regarding Development of Green Chemistry Curriculum

Dear Ms Santiago;

Enclosed is the Phase II Interim Report regarding the supplemental environmental project (SEP) that Presstek, Inc. (Presstek) is in the process of executing regarding the Consent Agreement and Final Order as captioned in the docket numbers above. Presstek has engaged Beyond Benign Foundation to work with the Quincy High School in Massachusetts to develop a Green Chemistry Curriculum.

During the 2008/2009 academic school year, Beyond Benign assisted the Quincy Public High School teachers in piloting the Green Chemistry Curriculum that was developed during the summer of 2008. The materials were developed so that high school teachers could use these resources to conduct a summer or regular semester program on Green Chemistry.

A summary of the program and its performance is included in the enclosed report.

A Green Chemistry workshop was conducted on June 26, 2009. A brief description of the workshop is provided in the attached report. The details regarding the workshop will be included in the Phase III interim report that will be submitted on or prior to September 30, 2009.

The level of interest in this program by the teachers and students is encouraging. I am hopeful that the curriculum can be used in other schools or workshop settings to encourage interest in the sciences and the development of products and processes using the principles of green chemistry.
