

In response to your request during a conference call on October 10, 2007, TRC Environmental Corporation (TRC) performed a visual inspection of a concrete pad where waste containers were stored (the waste pad) in 2003 at the above-referenced facility (the facility). The visual inspection of the waste pad was conducted on October 12, 2007, and was performed as a result of Paragraph 35(b) of the settlement agreement between EMCO Chemical Distributors, Inc. (EMCO) and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Paragraph 35(b) of the settlement agreement stated that EMCO must, by October 27, 2007, retain the services of a professional engineering firm to inspect, sample and/or analyze for any evidence of chemical spills or releases in the area where the drums/containers of concern were stored. The drums/containers of concern were noted in a 2003 facility inspection by the EPA to be over the 10-day storage limit for hazardous wastes for transfer facilities, specified in 40 CFR Part 263 – Standards Applicable to Transporters of Hazardous Waste.

According to the waste manifests for the drums/containers of concern, the wastes were generated by TEG Glenview, LLC of Glenview, Illinois, and were first stored on the waste pad from April 24 to 29, 2003. Also, according to the waste manifests, the drums/containers were removed from the facility from May 9 to August 2, 2003. A total of 59 drums/containers held various mixed hazardous waste products (and some non-hazardous waste) on the waste pad. The various

products are listed on the waste manifests included in Attachment A. All of the drums/containers were transported for proper disposal to the Pollution Control Industries of Indiana (PCI) facility in East Chicago, Indiana.

On October 12, 2007, Mr. Michael Lawrence, Project Manager of TRC, met up with you and Ms. Tina Levitt, Director of Environment, Health and Safety with EMCO, at the facility. Ms. Levitt was present during the time of the inspection by the EPA in 2003. Ms. Levitt stated that all of the drums and containers of concern were in good condition the entire time they were stored on the waste pad in 2003. In addition, she stated that none of the drums/containers were rejected for disposal by the disposal facility. During the visual inspection of the waste pad, Mr. Lawrence noted minor staining on the pad but nothing beyond what might be expected considering the purpose/function of the pad. In addition, Mr. Lawrence observed that the concrete waste pad was in good condition (i.e., no significant cracks or other defects). According to Ms. Levitt, the concrete waste pad has never been replaced since the time when the drums/containers of concern were stored on the pad. A photographic log from TRC's visit to the facility's waste pad is provided as Attachment B.

Based on drum conditions observed by EMCO personnel in 2003, the acceptance of the drums/containers for disposal by PCI, and the concrete waste pad still appears in good condition, no evidence is present of chemical spills or releases in the area where the drums/containers of concern were stored. Therefore, further intrusive subsurface investigation methods (e.g., sampling soil underneath the waste pad) are not necessary.

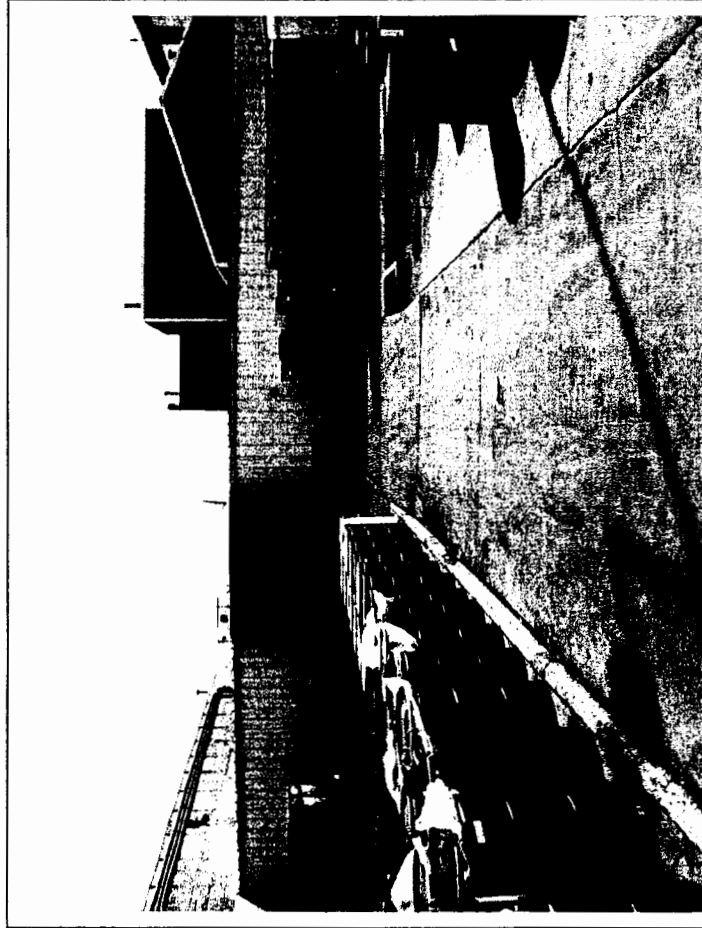

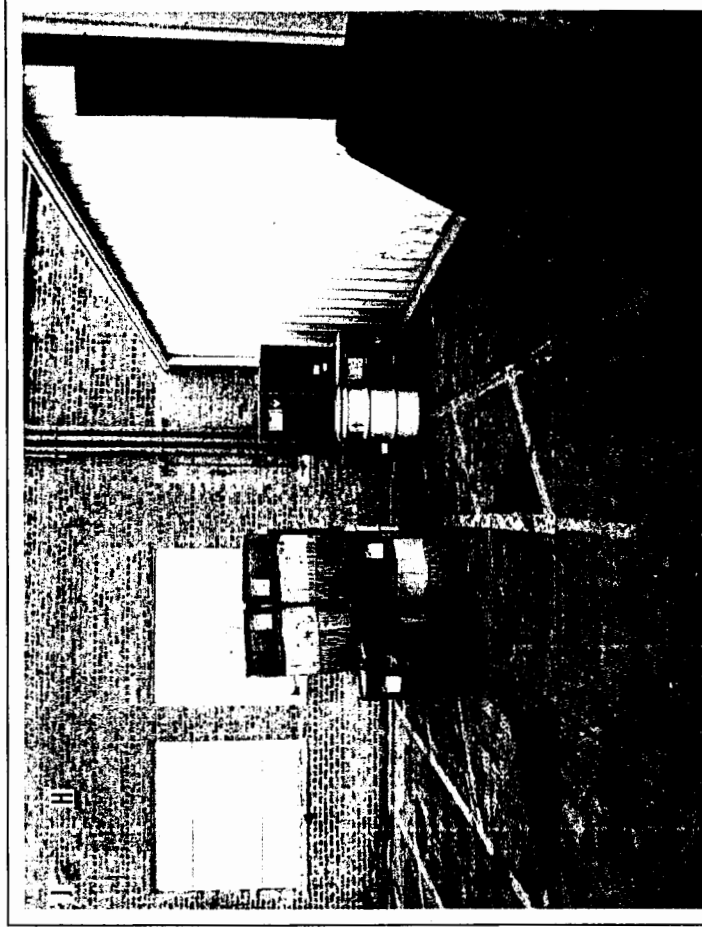

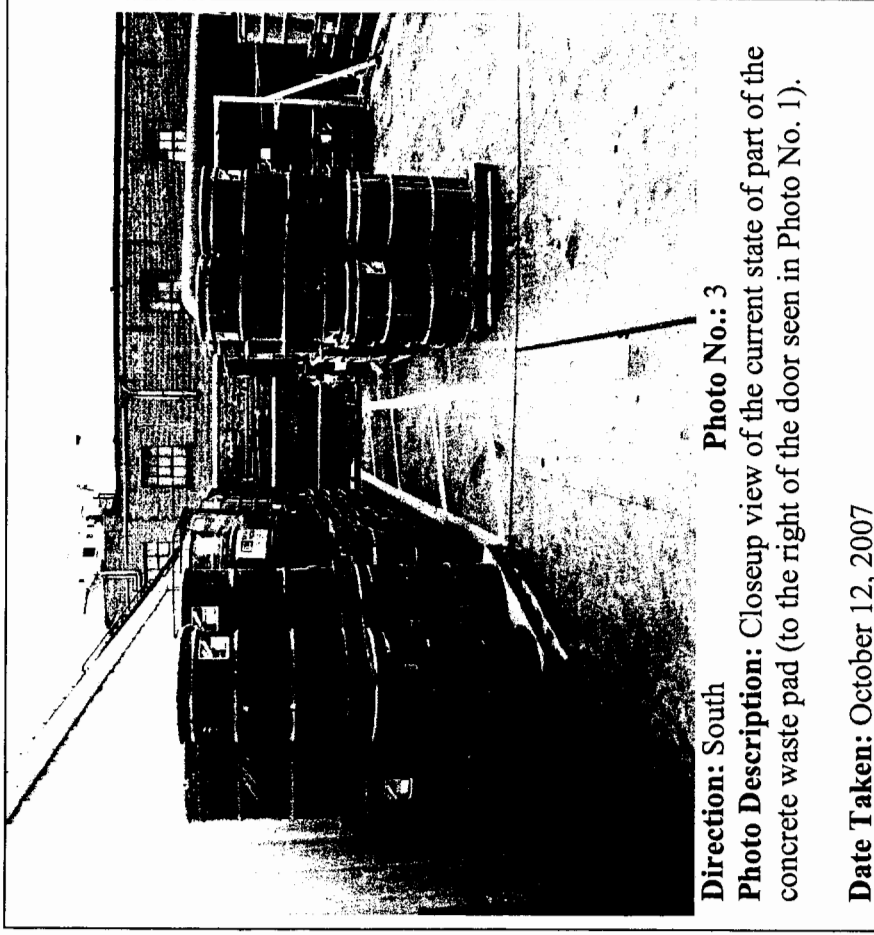
