On November 16, 2009, Lin-Cor Environmental, LLC ("Respondent") filed a unilateral motion to extend the Answer period in this matter. The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 1 ("EPA" or "the Agency") opposes this motion. As grounds for this opposition, EPA states as follows:

- On June 30, 2009, EPA filed an Administrative Complaint against Respondent;
- On June 30, 2009, EPA and Respondent discussed this matter. Respondent indicated its desire to engage in settlement discussions with EPA and to pursue an ability to pay claim in this matter;
- 3. On or about July 1, 2009, Respondent received the Complaint;
- 4. On July 31, 2009, Respondent filed a motion to extend the Answer period until September 1, 2009, in order to engage in settlement discussions with EPA. EPA consented to this motion. The Regional Judicial Officer granted this motion;

- Respondent scheduled to meet with EPA on August 12, 2009. Respondent cancelled this meeting;
- On August 31, 2009, Respondent filed a motion to extend the Answer period until October 1, 2009, in order to engage in settlement discussions with EPA. EPA consented to this motion. The Regional Judicial Officer granted this motion;
- On September 10, 2009, EPA advised Respondent that it needed to submit numerous specific materials in support of its ability to pay claim by September 25, 2009;
- Respondent failed to submit the requisite materials in support of its ability to pay claim by September 25, 2009;
- On September 29, 2009, EPA contacted Respondent regarding its failure to submit the requisite materials in support of its ability to pay claim;
- On September 29, 2009, Respondent provided EPA with two documents in support of its ability to pay claim;
- 11. On September 30, 2009, Respondent filed a motion to extend the Answer period until November 2, 2009, in order to continue settlement discussions with EPA. EPA consented to this motion. The Regional Judicial Officer granted this motion;
- 12. On October 1, 2009, Respondent met with EPA to engage in settlement discussions. During this meeting, Respondent restated its intent to pursue an ability to pay claim in this matter. EPA informed Respondent that it must submit numerous additional materials to support its ability to pay claim by

October 16, 2009. EPA advised Respondent that the Agency would not consent to any further motions to extend the Answer period;

- Respondent failed to submit the required information in support of its ability to pay claim by the October 16, 2009 deadline;
- 14. On October 21, 2009, EPA contacted Respondent regarding its failure to submit the requisite materials in support of its ability to pay claim. EPA received no response from Respondent;
- 15. Respondent failed to file an Answer by the November 2, 2009 deadline,
- On November 4, 2009, EPA contacted Respondent regarding its failure to submit an Answer. EPA received no response from Respondent;
- 17. On November 12, 2009, EPA contacted Respondent regarding its failure to submit an Answer and advised Respondent that EPA intended to move for default judgment in this matter unless Respondent filed an Answer imminently;
- On November 16, 2009, Respondent filed an Answer and unilateral motion to extend the Answer period until December 2, 2009;
- 19. Given that Respondent received an additional 90 days to submit an Answer, had full and fair notice of the Answer deadline, was unresponsive to multiple EPA inquiries, failed to submit materials necessary to facilitate a settlement agreement, and failed to submit a timely Answer, an extension of the Answer period is neither reasonable nor warranted.
