ORDER ON MOTION TO REVISE CONSENT AGREEMENT

On September 24, 2010, Respondents filed an Unopposed Motion to Revise Consent Agreement. The Motion requests that the Consent Agreement be modified to change the Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP") that was originally agreed to in the April, 2008 Consent Agreement. The reason for the change relates to Respondents' inability to spend all the necessary money as contemplated in the Consent Agreement. Respondents' wish to do an additional project to ensure the shortfall amount is spent and the SEP provisions are met. The new project provides funds to conduct drinking water testing and is intended to protect the health and environment on the Fort Peck Reservation. This additional SEP meets the intent of the original Consent Agreement.

On September 27, 2010, Complainant filed EPA Comments on Respondents' Motion to Revise Consent Agreement. The Agency supports the revision to the Consent Agreement and agrees that the additional SEP supports the parties' goal to protect drinking water sources and the health of local residents.

THEREFORE, the Motion to Revise Consent Agreement is GRANTED. All provisions of the April 28, 2008, Consent Agreement and Final Order still remain in effect pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.18(b).

ORDER. Respondents shall spend \$12,566.00, the shortfall amount from the original SEP, no later than 4 months from the date of this Final Order.
