Dear President Spang:

On June 29, 2012, the EPA issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order) to the Northern Cheyenne Tribal Council and the Northern Cheyenne Utility Commission (NCUC). The Order was issued following a loss of pressure in the community of Ashland and our understanding that pressure had also been lost in Birney. The EPA later learned that Birney had been able to maintain enough water in its tank to prevent a pressure loss and amended the Order to remove requirements for Birney.

Manager Winslow Whitecrane and his staff have met all requirements of the Order. Required special samples were collected and all showed the water to be safe to drink. The regular monitoring schedule for the system is now in effect. Please pass along our thanks to all of your staff who assisted during the emergencies this summer.
