This letter is to inform you of the Environmental Protection Agency's decision to close the Administrative Order (Order) issued to Greater Wyoming Council (formerly Central Wyoming Council), Boy Scouts of America, for the Camp Buffalo Bill Public Water System on January 25, 2011. The EPA has determined that you have complied with the requirements of the Order and therefore we will close it at this time.

Please be aware that you are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (Drinking Water Regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the Drinking Water Regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
