Respondent has reached agreement with EPA on the terms of a proposed Complaint and Consent Agreement/Final Order which would resolve this matter. Under the proposed Complaint and Consent Agreement/Final Order, Respondent will pay a civil penalty of \$47,000. Final approval of the proposed Complaint and Consent Agreement/Final Order is subject to the requirements of 40 C.F.R. § 22.45.

The EPA will receive written comments on the proposed Complaint and Consent Agreement/Final Order for a period of forty (40) days from the date of publication of this notice. The procedures by which the public may submit written comments on a proposed Class II order or participate in a Class II proceeding, and the procedures by which a respondent my request a hearing, are set forth in the Consolidated Rules.
