The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers reviewed the information Ms. Ronda Sandquist provided on behalf of C-2 Construction and Iron Man Enterprises, LLC, on November 7, 2023. This letter is to inform you of the EPA's decision, made in consultation with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, to terminate the August 8, 2018, Administrative Order on Consent (Consent Order), Docket No. CWA-08-2018-0013, with C-2 Construction and Iron Man Enterprises, LLC (Respondents).

Respondents have demonstrated satisfactory completion of the actions required by the Consent Order and Restoration and Mitigation Plan,<sup>1</sup> in accordance with paragraph 47 of the Consent Order.

Please be advised that the Respondents are required to comply with the Clean Water Act (CWA), its implementing regulations, and any applicable permits after the termination of the Consent Order.
