On August 18, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order) under section 1431 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (the Act), 40 U.S.C. § 300i, to Y-O Investments, Inc., as owner of the Y-O Ranch Estates public water system (the system). This letter confirms the verbal notice provided to you by Mario Mérida of EPA on September 21, 2009, that weekly bacteriological monitoring in the distribution system is no longer required. At this time, you may initiate monthly bacteriological monitoring. This notice is based on bacteriological monitoring conducted on September 1, September 10, and September 16, 2009, which were analyzed as total coliform and E. coli-negative. Y-O Investments, Inc. is required to comply with all other provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.

We appreciate your ongoing cooperation, including submission of your draft compliance plan on September 11, 2009, a proposal which EPA will be addressing separately.
