On July 18, 2008, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order) under section 1431 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (the Act), 40 U.S.C. § 300i, to you, owner and/or operator of the Flying X Ranch Mobile Home Park public water system (the System). This letter confirms the verbal notice provided to Michelle Arrick, Office Administrator at Flying X Ranch Mobile Home Park, by Shawn McCaffrey of EPA on July 30, 2008 regarding reduced monitoring and rescission of the public notification (boil order) and alternate water source requirements under the Order. Additionally, this letter serves as written notice that effective July 30, 2008, pursuant to the Order, daily bacteriological monitoring in the distribution system is no longer required and may be reduced to weekly monitoring (two samples per week). This notice is based on bacteriological monitoring conducted on July 21, July 22, and July 24, 2008 which were analyzed as total coliform negative. Weekly bacteriological monitoring shall be conducted until you are notified by EPA that sampling may be reduced to monthly. Additionally, you may discontinue the public notice required by the Order and may discontinue the provision of an alternative potable water supply. The System is required to comply with all other provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
