SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO ANSWER


Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b), Respondents Daniel J. Lynch and Grace K. Lynch respectfully request a second 30 day extension to June 15, 2008 to file a written Answer to the Complainant's Administrative Complaint in this action. As grounds for this motion, Respondents state as follows:

1. Respondents intend to enter into a settlement with EPA and to incorporate a Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP") as part of said settlement.
2. An initial 30 day extension has been granted. During the first extension period, April 15 to May 15, 2008, Respondents actively gathered information regarding the SEP to be proposed, worked with their contractor of choice to obtain the necessary training, negotiated the terms of a contract to perform the work set forth in the SEP, reviewed the proposal with a licensed lead inspector to discuss work, timing, and costs, and drafted and forwarded a proposed SEP and COFA to EPA for review and negotiation.
3. The SEP and COFA were forwarded to EPA's lead attorney, John Kilborn, on

May 8, 2008.

4. Additional time is required to negotiate the final terms of the SEP and COFA.
5. Respondents are not aware of any prejudice to the interests of the Complainant.
6. Attorney John Kilborn, Senior Counsel for the Complainant, has indicated that the Complainant will not oppose the instant motion.


