
Dear Mr. Kott:

This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order (Order), issued to the Lame Deer High School public water system on March 8, 2010. The EPA has determined that the Lame Deer High School public water supply system has complied with the terms of the Order and, therefore, we will close it at this time.

Please be aware that the Lame Deer High School is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
