Dear Mayor Dellinger and Mr. Dasher:

This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Administrative Order (Emergency Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2008-0057, issued to the Town of Mountain View, owner of the Town of Mountain View water system (the System) on May 21, 2008. The EPA has determined that the System has completed all actions outlined in EPA's May 21, 2008 Emergency Order and that the water provided by the Town of Mountain View water system no longer presents an imminent and substantial endangerment to the public health. Therefore EPA will close the Emergency Order at this time.

Please be aware that the Town of Mountain View is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations ("NPDWR"), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs or an Administrative Order may result in a court-imposed injunction and penalties of up to \$32,500 per day of violation.
