The above-referenced Administrative Orders for Compliance on Consent were issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to the city of Jefferson under the authority of Section 309(a) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(a). The EPA has determined that all requirements of the AOCs have been adequately met.

This letter serves as a notification to you that the EPA is terminating the AOCs. The decision to terminate the AOCs is conditioned upon the accuracy of your representations to the EPA in response to the requirements of the AOCs. Termination of the AOCs in no way relieves you of the obligation to comply with your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits and all applicable statutes and regulations. The effect of this termination is limited to the requirements imposed under the AOCs. The EPA reserves all of its authorities, both legal and equitable, under the CWA and any other statutory, regulatory, or common law authorities of the United States.
