

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## EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the Complainant, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 10 (EPA), and by Respondent pursuant to Section 113(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(3) and (d), and by 40 C.F.R. § 22.13(b). On August 31, 2005, EPA obtained the concurrence of the U.S. Department of Justice, pursuant to Section 113(d)(1) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d)(1), to pursue this administrative enforcement action.

#### **ALLEGED VIOLATIONS**

EPA found that Respondent had violated regulations implementing Section 112(r) of the Act at 40 C.F.R. Part 68 by failing to comply with the regulations as noted on the enclosed Risk Management Plan Inspection Findings and Alleged Violations Summary and the Risk Management Plan Inspection Findings, Alleged Violations and Proposed Penalty Sheet, which are hereby incorporated by reference.

#### **SETTLEMENT**

In consideration of Respondent's size of business, its full compliance history, its good-faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record, the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations, described in the enclosed Summary and Sheet for the total penalty amount of \$2,610.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions:

Respondent, by signing below, waives any objections that it may have regarding jurisdiction, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein and in the Summary and Sheet, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above.

The ESA, when executed by both parties, is binding on EPA and Diamond Fruit Growers upon receipt of the signed original document. Upon receipt, EPA will take no further action against Diamond Fruit Growers for the violations cited in the ESA. EPA will neither accept nor approve the ESA if returned more than 45 days after the date of Diamond Fruit Growers's receipt of this letter, unless an extension has been granted by EPA.

If Diamond Fruit Growers does not pay the penalty and return the signed original ESA within 45 days of receipt (90 days if an extension has been granted), this settlement offer will be automatically withdrawn, without prejudice to EPA's ability to file another enforcement action for the cited violations. EPA may seek penalties of up to \$27,500 per day for each violation (\$32,500 per day after March 15, 2004).

Diamond Fruit Growers is required in the ESA to certify that it has corrected the violations and paid the penalty. The payment for the penalty amount must be in the form of a cashier's check or certified check payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America" with the docket number of the ESA on the check. The docket number is located at the top left corner of the ESA.

After the Regional Administrator signs the original ESA and it is filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk, EPA will send Diamond Fruit Growers a file-stamped copy.
