
On August 18, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order) under section 1431 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (the Act), 40 U.S.C. § 300i, to Y-O Investments, Inc. as owner of the Y-O Ranch Estates public water system (the system). This letter confirms the verbal notice provided to you by Lisa Kahn of EPA on September 2, 2009, regarding reduced monitoring and rescission of the public notification boil order and alternate water source requirements under the Order.

Additionally this letter serves as written notice that effective September 2, 2009, pursuant to the Order, daily bacteriological monitoring in the distribution system is no longer required and may be reduced to weekly monitoring (one sample per week). This notice is based on bacteriological monitoring conducted on August 26, 27 and 28 which were analyzed as total coliform negative. Weekly bacteriological monitoring shall be conducted until you are notified by EPA that sampling may be reduced to monthly.


You may discontinue the public notice required by the Order and may discontinue the provision of an alternative potable water supply at this time. Y-O Investments, Inc. is required to comply with all other provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
