## ORDER ON COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT PREHEARING EXCHANGE

By Motion dated March 18, 2009, Complainant moved to supplement its prehearing exchange to add two additional documents.<sup>1</sup> The Motion indicated that Respondent did not object to granting the relief sought.

The Motion is hereby, GRANTED, as set forth below:

Good cause exists for the granting of the Motion: Complainant submitted its initial prehearing exchange in this case in a timely manner; the Motion indicates that the documents were publically accessible at all times; Respondent will suffer no prejudice as a result of the inclusion of the supplemental documents and has, in fact, consented to their addition; and the hearing of this matter is not scheduled to begin until June 2009, three months from now. Rule 22.19(f), of the Consolidated Rules of Practice (40 C.F.R. § 22.19(f)) permits just this type of supplementation. Therefore, the Complainant's Motion is well-founded.
