### **ANSWER**

COMES NOW RESPONDENT, by and through its attorneys and for its answer to the Complaint herein:

- 1. Admits the allegations contained in paragraphs 1-4 of the Complaint
- 2. Denies the allegations contained in paragraph 5 of the Complaint
- 3. Admits the allegations contained in paragraphs 6-12 of the Complaint to the extent that they represent the current law
- 4. Denies the allegations contained in paragraphs 13-15 of the Complaint
- 5. Admits that an inspection occurred in 2003 and denies the remaining allegations contained in paragraph 16 of the Complaint
- 6. Admits that an inspection occurred in May of 2005 and denies the remaining allegations contained in paragraph 17 of the Complaint
- 7. Denies the allegations contained in paragraphs 18-114

#### FURTHER ANSWERING RESPONDENT STATES AFFIRMATIVELY THAT:

- 8. Even if the violations are proven, the proposed penalty is not appropriate relative to the gravity of the alleged violations
- 9. Imposition of the proposed penalty will severely jeopardize or destroy the ability of Respondent to continue in business
- 10. The proposed penalty exceeds 4% of Respondents' income

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- 11. Complainant failed to advise Respondent that any re-registrations were required
- 12. Complainant failed to give Respondent adequate notice that its relevant registrations had been cancelled
- 13. Complainant failed to warn Respondent of any potential violations prior to issuance of its 2005 Stop Sale Order or the Complaint
- 14. Complainant failed to issue a Stop Sale, Use, or Removal Order after the cancellations of the relevant registrations and prior to any alleged sale of previously registered products, which would have avoided the alleged violations

## FURTHER ANSWERING, RESPONDENT:

- 15. Requests a Settlement Conference
- 16. Demands a Hearing

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that the Complaint be dismissed.
