This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2010-0033, issued to the Campbell County School District No. 1, owner and/or operator of the 4-J School water system, on April 19, 2010. EPA has determined that the Campbell County School District No. 1 has complied with the requirements of the Administrative Order and therefore we will close the Order at this time.

Please be aware that the Campbell County School District No. 1 is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWRs), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
