Dear Ms: Walters:

On December 13, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Underground Storage Tank (UST) Section issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement (Field Citation) concerning UST violations (i.e., failure to test/inspect spill and overfill every 3 years; calibration of leak detection equipment; release detection documents) found at the FAA Cleveland facilities located at 326 East Lorain Street, Oberlin, Ohio 44074.

On April 6, 2022, EPA received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement and supporting documentation. Also on May 16, 2022, the EPA finance office confirmed receipt of your payment (check #1222) for a total of \$2,480.00 in penalties.

The Settlement Agreement states that it is effective upon EPA's final approval. I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in the EPA's files. We also have accepted and processed your second check as part of the settlement process.
