ORDER

Respondents have filed a Motion for Extension of Time seeking an additional 90 days in which to answer the Complaint filed in this matter. The Complaint includes over 4000 counts alleging violations of the Section 1018 of the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 and involves over 400 lease agreements. Complainant seeks a penalty of \$5,489,240.

The Parties participated in a telephone conference call on Tuesday, October 11, 2011, to discuss Respondents' Motion. At that time, counsel for Complainant advised that it did not oppose Respondents' motion.

Accordingly, pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b) and for good cause shown, Respondents' Motion for Extension of Time is hereby GRANTED. Respondents shall have additional 90 days, to and including **January 24, 2012**, in which to answer the Complaint or otherwise plead in this matter.


