
Dear Mayor Norgaard:

This letter is to inform you and the City of Poplar(City) of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's decision to close the above-referenced Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2015-0011, issued to the City as the owner and/or operator of the City of the Poplar public water system, on April 14, 2015. The EPA has determined that the City has complied with the requirements of the Order and, therefore, the EPA will close the Order at this time.

Please be aware that the City is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (regulations) at 40 C.F.R. part 141 at the public water system. Violation of these regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,561 per day of violation.
