ORDER GRANTING SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By Motion dated March 26, 2009, the Complainant moved for an extension of time to file the Consent Agreement and Final Order. The Motion fails to indicate the Respondents' position in regard thereto.

Section 22.7(b) of the Rules of Practice (40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b)) provides that the Presiding Officer may grant an extension of time for filing any document upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties.

The Motion is hereby, GRANTED, as set forth below:

Good cause exists for the granting of the Motion in that it is in the interest of the parties and judicial economy for the parties to settle this matter on mutually agreeable terms rather than litigate the matter to conclusion. The Motion indicates that the parties are circulating for concurrence and signature a Consent Agreement and require an additional two week period to complete the process. In that a hearing in this case has yet to be scheduled, no prejudice will result from a brief delay. Therefore, the parties shall have until April 15, 2009 to file the fully executed Consent Agreement and Final Order.
