Dear Mr. Cruz:

This letter is to inform you of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Orders (Orders) issued to the USDA Forest Service, Medicine Bow National Forest (MBNF), as owner and/or operator of the Bobbie Thompson and Pelton Creek Campgrounds on July 2, 2012. The EPA has determined that the MBNF has complied with the requirements of the Orders and therefore we will close them at this time.

Please be aware that the MBNF is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
