ORDER GRANTING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

This report is made pursuant to an Order Initiating Alternative Dispute Resolution Process designating the undersigned Administrative Law Judge as a neutral. By terms of that Order, the ADR process was scheduled to terminate on **February 12, 2008**.

In that the parties are progressing in their settlement negotiations, but anticipating that a Consent Agreement would not be executed before the applicable deadline, and have requested an extension of not more than 30 days, the undersigned grants the extension of ADR until **March 12, 2008**. Such extension should provide the parties sufficient time to file a fully executed Consent Agreement disposing of the case. Should a Consent Agreement not be executed by that date, this case will be reassigned to an Administrative Law Judge for litigation.


