
Dear Mr. Farrer:

This letter is to inform you of the EPA's decision to close the Administrative Order (Order) issued to the Grand Teton Council Boy Scouts of America, Inc. (Council) on September 28, 2015, regarding the Treasure Mountain Scout Camp Public Water System. The EPA has determined that the Council has complied with the requirements of the Order.

Please be aware that the Council is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$53,907 per day of violation.
