Pursuant to paragraph 12 of the Administrative Order (AO) issued July 8, 2013, to the Flying X Ranch Corp. (Flying X Ranch or the Ranch), this Addendum to the AO incorporates the schedule for completing actions as outlined in the July 15, 2013 letter to EPA (and faxed to EPA on July 16, 2013) from Raymond Parker on behalf of Flying X Ranch. This letter constitutes the written approval by EPA of Flying X Ranch's schedule as indicated in the chart below.

Action Completed by Date


1. Correct problem of sheared piping at the storage cistern.	July, 2012
2. Receive technical assistance from the Wyoming Association of Rural Water Systems (WARWS), to include technical assistance on reactivating and calibrating the chlorinator in order to maintain residual chlorine at appropriate level for disinfection.	July 11, 2013
3. Reactivate chlorinator.	July 11, 2013
4. Come into and remain in compliance with the total coliform MCL no later than the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Quarter (July-September), 2013.	3 <sup>rd</sup> Quarter (July - Sept.), 2013
5. Test residual chlorine once per month while serving water to the public and provide monthly result to EPA within 10 days following the end of the month, until notified otherwise.	Upon receipt of Addendum

Consistent with paragraph 12 of the AO, the "Completed by Date" deadlines above are now enforceable requirements of the AO.

Please note that EPA expects this approved schedule to be met. While not creating any right to an extension, EPA may in its discretion consider granting an extension to any deadline in the schedule under limited circumstances. If unexpected events occur that are beyond the Ranch's control and that may prompt the Ranch to request an extension of these deadlines, the Ranch will be responsible for notifying EPA well in advance of the deadline dates. EPA will not consider extending these deadlines without a clear justification for their need. The Ranch must provide the following information in any request for extensions: a description of the work that has been completed and the additional work that may not be completed by the deadline dates, the unexpected events that occurred and how Respondent attempted to foresee or overcome these obstacles, the proposed new deadline dates, and an explanation that justifies the new proposed deadline dates.

Please be advised that Flying X Ranch is required to comply with all provisions of the AO. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
