Pursuant to agreement of the parties and the Order of Judge Biro, dated May 12, 2009, the parties participated in Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) via a conference call with Judge Nissen on June 5, 2009. On June 24, 2009, the parties reached a settlement in principle. Pursuant to Judge Biro's Order, ADR is set to expire on June 30, 2009. EPA is in the process of drafting a proposed Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO) that will be sent to Respondent's owner, Mr. Wesley Haigh, sometime this week. Once Mr. Haigh signs the CAFO, it will be signed by the Acting Director of Region 4's Air, Pesticides, and Toxics Management Division and presented to the Regional Hearing Clerk for approval.

The undersigned counsel for EPA has conferred with Mr. Haigh and he has indicated that he concurs in this Motion seeking a 30-day extension of ADR in order to provide the parties the necessary time to finalize the CAFO.

WHEREFORE, the parties hereby request that Judge Nissen grant a 30-day extension to the ADR period.
