JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PRE-HEARING EXCHANGES

Pursuant to the Pre-Hearing Order dated December 12, 2007, the Parties hereby respectfully request a 28-day extension of time until <u>March 10, 2008</u>, to file their pre-hearing exchanges. The reasons the parties need and request this extension of time are as follows:

- 1. In the past two weeks, an attorney at the law firm of counsel representing the Respondent Logan County Water Pollution Control District unexpectedly changed employment. As a result of the departure of this attorney, the undersigned attorney has been required to step into other projects and matters for which previously he had no responsibility on an urgent basis. In addition, no other attorney at the firm of the undersigned counsel is knowledgeable on the matters of this case.
- 2. Upon determining that it would be difficult to meet the current deadline for filing pre-trial exchanges, the undersigned counsel for Respondent contacted the undersigned counsel for the U.S. EPA and requested the extension of time. The undersigned counsel for the U.S. EPA agreed to the 28-day extension of time requested herein.
- 3. In addition, the undersigned counsel for the U.S. EPA informed the undersigned counsel for the Respondent that she had just returned to work from an unexpected period of hospitalization and anticipated that additional time would be needed to prepare the exchange. Over the past several months, counsel for the U.S EPA has worked out of the office for health reasons. Thus, the undersigned counsel for the U.S. EPA joins in this motion for an extension of time to file the pre-hearing exchanges.

For all of these reasons, the Parties hereby respectfully request a 28-day extension of time until **March 10, 2008**, to file their pre-hearing exchanges.
