Dear Mr. and Mrs. Bishop:

This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Administrative Order (Emergency Order), issued on July 21, 2009 to you as owners/operators of the Medicine Bow Lodge public water system. EPA has determined that you have completed all actions outlined in the Emergency Order and in EPA's Emergency Administrative Order Addendum dated September 24, 2009, and that the water provided by the Medicine Bow Lodge public water system no longer presents an imminent and substantial endangerment to public health. Therefore EPA will close the Emergency Order at this time.

Please be aware that you are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWR), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
