

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Chief Administrative Law Judge's Order of June 1, 2015 provides that this alternative dispute resolution ("ADR") process terminates August 3, 2015. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for one month, to September 3, 2015.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations are ongoing. In a conference call on August 6, 2015 the parties agreed to an extension of the ADR process.
