Re: Notice of Safe Drinking Water Act Enforcement Action against Circle J Ranch PWS ID WY5601165

Dear Commissioners:

The Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) requires that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) notify locally elected officials of certain enforcement actions taken in their area.

An Administrative Order is being issued to the United Methodist Circle J Ranch. This Order requires that the United Methodist Circle J Ranch, as owner and/or operator of the Circle J Ranch public water system (System), take measures to return the System to compliance with the SDWA and the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations. The violations include failure to monitor for nitrate in 2012 and failure to notify the EPA of the violation.

This is the second Order issued to Circle J by the EPA. The first Order is still in full force and effect.

Dear Ms. Anderson:

Enclosed is an Administrative Order (Order) issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the authority of section 1414(g) of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300g-3(g). Among other things, the Order alleges that United Methodist Circle J Ranch (Circle J), as owner and/or operator of the Circle J Ranch water system (System), has violated the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations at 40 C.F.R. part 141 (Drinking Water Regulations).

The Order is effective upon the date received. Please review the Order and within 10 days provide the EPA with any information you believe the EPA may not have.

If Circle J complies with the Order, the EPA may close the Order without further action. Failure to comply with the Order may lead to substantial civil penalties and/or a federal court injunction ordering compliance. On January 10, 2013, the EPA issued an Order, docket #SDWA-08-2013-0008, to Circle J for violation of the drinking water regulations that are separate from the violations noted in this Order. Please be advised that the first Order is still in full force and effect.

 This Order is issued under the authority vested in the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) by section 1414(g) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (Act), 42 U.S.C. § 300g-3(g), as properly delegated to the undersigned officials.

2. United Methodist Circle J Ranch (Respondent) is a Wyoming corporation that owns and/or operates the Circle J Ranch Water System (System), which provides piped water to the public in Washakie County, Wyoming, for human consumption.

3. The System is supplied by a groundwater source consisting of two wells. The System's water is not treated. The System is seasonally operated May through August.

4. The System has approximately 21 service connections and/or regularly serves an average of approximately 200 individuals daily for at least 60 days out of the year. Therefore, the System is a "public water system" as defined in section 1401(4) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300f(4), and 40 C.F.R. § 141.2. The System is also a "transient, non-community water system" as defined in 40 C.F.R. § 141.2.

5. Respondent is subject to the Act and the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (Drinking Water Regulations) at 40 C.F.R. part 141. The Drinking Water Regulations are "applicable requirements" as defined in section 1414(i) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300g-3(i).

VIOLATIONS

Respondent is required to monitor the System's water annually for nitrate.
40 C.F.R. § 141.23(d). Respondent failed to monitor the System's water for nitrate during 2012, and, therefore, violated this requirement.

7. Respondent is required to report any failure to comply with any Drinking Water Regulation to the EPA within 48 hours (except where the Drinking Water Regulations specify a different time period). 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(b). Respondent failed to report the violation cited in paragraph 6, above, to the EPA and, therefore, violated this requirement.

ORDER

Based on the above violations, Respondent is ordered to perform the following actions upon Respondent's receipt of this Order (unless a different deadline is specified below):

8. Within 30 days after receipt of this Order, and as required by the Drinking Water Regulations thereafter, Respondent shall monitor the System's water for nitrate. 40 C.F.R. § 141.23. Respondent shall report analytical results to the EPA within the first 10 days following the month in which

Respondent received sample results, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(a). Respondent shall report any violation of the nitrate monitoring requirements to the EPA within 48 hours of the violation occurring, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(b).

Respondent shall direct all reporting required by this Order to:

GENERAL PROVISIONS

10. This Order shall not constitute a waiver, suspension, or modification of any requirement of the Act or Drinking Water Regulations. Issuance of this Order is not an election by the EPA to forgo any civil or criminal action.

 Violation of any part of this Order or the Drinking Water Regulations may subject Respondent to a civil penalty of up to \$37,500 (as adjusted for inflation) per day of violation. 42 U.S.C. § 300g-3; 40 C.F.R. part 19.

 Respondent may seek federal judicial review of the Order pursuant to section 1448(a) of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300j-7(a).

 This Order is effective upon receipt by Respondent and will continue to be in effect until closed by the EPA.
