The Parker Hannifin Facility in McCook, Nebraska, has an open Administrative Order on Consent requiring the completion of a RCRA Facility Investigation and if necessary, performance of a Corrective Measures Study pursuant to Section 3013 of the Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

The Parker Hannifin facility was constructed in 1971 with several additions constructed during the 1990s. Though the site facility has gone through several ownerships, it has been used to manufacture domestic, industrial, and automotive hoses and belts since its inception in 1971. Generally, the facility consists of rubber mixing, extruding, and vulcanizing processes along with associated material storage areas, a maintenance area and an office area.

All requirements of the 2012 Order have been met or have been waived due to the low level of contamination discovered during the RFI. In accordance with Section XXII - Termination and Satisfaction, Paragraph 153, I recommend that you sign below to formally terminate the Order.
