The EPA is closing the July 19, 2018, Emergency Administrative Order (Order) at the Agnes Leggins Public Water System (PWS ID# 083090049) on the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation. Two safe weekly special-purpose samples were collected on 9/13/2018 and 9/17/2018. The EPA has determined that the requirements of the Order have been completed.

Please be aware that you are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties.

Thank you for resolving these issues. I especially wanted to thank Mr. Ray King for keeping the EPA informed of the status of the Agnes Leggins Public Water System during this Emergency Administrative Order. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact me.
