AMENDED ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND ADR PERIOD

The complaint in this proceeding under Section 309(g) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(g), seeks to assess a penalty of \$177,500 against respondents for the discharge of fill material into waters of the United States (wetlands) without a permit from the Secretary of the Army in accordance with Section 404 of the Act 33 U.S.C. § 1344. The filled wetlands were used to store automobiles, trucks, heavy equipment, trailers, discarded material, lumber and old steel. Respondents answered, essentially admitting the violations, but claiming to have acted in good faith. EPA ordered respondents to remove the fill. Respondents have raised an "ability to pay" issue claiming that clean up work to date has completely exhausted their resources and that it is impossible for respondents to complete the scope of work outlined by EPA and pay the proposed penalty. The ADR period in this matter expires by its terms on July 25, 2011. Under date of July 12, 2011, complainant submitted a motion for extension of ADR Proceedings, alleging, inter alia, that the additional time would allow for further meetings in an attempt to resolve this matter. An extension will allow time for respondent to gather and complainant to review, data submitted in support of respondents' claim of inability to pay.

Good cause having been shown, the motion is granted and the ADR period is extended to and including August 24, 2011.
