- Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.13(b), Complainant, United States Environmental Protection
 Agency, Region 8 (EPA), and Respondent, The Boeing Company, by their undersigned
 representatives, hereby settle the civil cause of action arising out of violations of the Spill
 Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan regulations, and agree as follows:
- 2. The Clean Water Act (the Act), as amended, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6), authorizes the Administrator of EPA to assess administrative penalties against any person who violates the oil pollution prevention (SPCC) regulations, promulgated at 40 C.F.R. Part 112 under Section 311(j) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(j). This authority has been properly delegated to the undersigned EPA official.
- Respondent owns and/or operates the Boeing Helena Aeronautics Manufacturing Facility
 (Facility) located at 3200 Skyway Drive, Helena, Montana, in Lewis and Clark County.
- 4. The Facility is located approximately 1,000 yards from the Helena Valley Canal, which discharges to Lake Helena, which is tributary to the Missouri River, a traditional navigable water. Discharges of harmful quantities of oil from the Facility could reasonably be expected to reach navigable waters of the United States or adjoining shorelines.

- The Facility has a total storage capacity of approximately 6,837 gallons of oil and is subject to the SPCC regulations.
- Respondent admits its Facility is subject to the SPCC regulations.
- When Respondent purchased the Facility on December 21, 2010, there was no SPCC plan in place.
- At EPA's request, on March 15, 2012, Respondent submitted an SPCC plan dated April 2011, which EPA determined was not compliant with the SPCC regulations.
- On April 20, 2012, Respondent submitted a revised SPCC Plan dated April 11, 2012, which was compliant with the SPCC regulations.
- EPA determined that from the date of purchase on December 21, 2010, until April 11,
 2012, Respondent did not have an adequate SPCC Plan for the Facility in compliance with the SPCC regulations found at 40 C.F.R. § 112.3.
- 11. Respondent admits that EPA has jurisdiction in this proceeding.
- Respondent waives its right to a hearing before any civil tribunal to contest any issue of law or fact set forth in this Agreement.
- 13. This Agreement, upon incorporation into a final order, applies to and is binding upon EPA and upon Respondent and Respondent's heirs, successors and assigns. Any change in ownership or corporate status of Respondent, including but not limited to any transfer of assets or real or personal property, shall not alter Respondent's responsibilities under this Agreement.
- This Agreement contains all terms of the settlement agreed to by the parties.
- 15. Respondent consents and agrees to the assessment of a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 for violations of Section 311(j) of the Act, which shall be paid no later than thirty (30) days after the effective date of the Final Order by means of a cashier's or certified check, or by

wire transfer. If paying by check, the Respondent shall submit a cashier's or certified check, payable to "Environmental Protection Agency," and bearing the notations "OSLTF – 311" and the title and docket number of this case. If the Respondent sends payment by the U.S. Postal Service, the payment shall be addressed to:

- Respondent will implement and maintain an SPCC plan in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 112.
- 18. Respondent further agrees and consents that if Respondent fails to pay the penalty amount as required by this Agreement once incorporated into the Final Order, this Agreement is null and void, and EPA may pursue any applicable enforcement options.
- 19. The undersigned representative of Respondent certifies that he/she is fully authorized to enter into the terms and conditions for this Agreement and to bind Respondent to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 20. The parties agree to submit this Consent Agreement to the Regional Judicial Officer, with a request that it be incorporated into a final order.
- Each party shall bear its own costs and attorneys fees in connection with this matter.
- 22. This Consent Agreement, upon incorporation into a final order by the Regional Judicial Officer and full satisfaction by the parties, shall be a complete and full civil settlement of the specific violations described in this Agreement.
