## FOURTH JOINT ASSENTED-TO MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO ANSWER THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

# I. NEED FOR AN EXTENSION

On December 11 and 12, 2012, the Massachusetts Department of Transportation ("MassDOT") and J.H. Lynch and Sons, Inc. ("Lynch"), respectively, received Administrative Complaints and Notices of Opportunity to Request a Hearing in the above-captioned matter ("Complaint"). On January 28, 2013, both parties met with EPA Senior Enforcement Counsel Kathleen Woodward at an informal conference at EPA's Post Office Square location and engaged in extensive, productive settlement discussions. At the conclusion of this conference, all parties agreed to participate in a follow-up meeting, which was held on February 13, 2013 at MassDOT's District 4 Office in Weston, Massachusetts, to continue to explore the possibility of settlement in the above-captioned matter. On March 1<sup>st</sup> a conference call was held between respective counsels in order to expedite settlement. As of the time of this filing, the parties have settled and now need time to enter into a consent agreement.

Accordingly, MassDOT and Lynch request a fourteen (14) day extension of the deadline for filing an answer to the Complaint so that a mutually agreeable consent agreement may be entered into by all parties.

Attorney Woodward has indicated that she has no objections to this request of an extension of time to answer the Complaint until April 5, 2013.

#### II. AUTHORITY TO GRANT AN EXTENSION

The Presiding Officer may grant an extension of time for filing any document, including a written answer to an administrative complaint, upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties, under the Consolidated Rules of Practice, 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b). This motion is made in advance of the due date of March 25, 2013 in order to allow the Presiding Officer to issue an Order, especially in light of the acquiescence of Attorney Woodward to the issuance of the requested extension.

#### III. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Because there is no prejudice to any other party and there is good cause for an extension of time in which to file answers to the Complaint, MassDOT and Lynch respectfully request that the time for filing an answer to the Complaint be extended to April 5, 2013.
