Dear Mr. Montuoro and Mr. Wille:

On March 9, 2009, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2009-0038, ordering the Wyoming Department of Transportation (Respondent), as owner of the Evanston Port-of-Entry water system, to comply with various regulations issued by EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. § 300f et seq.

Paragraph 11 of the Order section, on pages 2 and 3 of the Order, required the Respondent to take daily samples of the chlorine residual in the distribution system and submit a monthly summary to EPA by the 10th day following each month. The daily chlorine residual monitoring and monthly reporting was required until notification by EPA that such requirements may cease.

This letter serves as notification that monthly reporting of the daily chlorine residual monitoring results to EPA is no longer required. This notice is based on eight continuous months of daily chlorine residual monitoring conducted at the Evanston Port-of-Entry and fourteen months of negative bacteriological monitoring results. EPA highly recommends that the system

continue to collect daily chlorine residual samples and retain the records on file as a means to ensure the system is properly working and public health is being protected. The system is required to comply with all other provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
