Hi Alan,

Why is there regulation in place for release of clean water into a watery area?

The CWA states specifically about pollutants, and the discharge system is entirely clean water based.

Even with the wastewater definition according to 40 CFR parts 401-500, those are specific for water treatment plants, water use from power facilities, and 40 CFR part 136 is for wastewater additives, not pure water release.

Was there tests done on the water deluge system that found pollutants?
