NOW COMES Complainant, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") through the undersigned attorney and respectfully alleges and prays as follows:

The Parties have been in active negotiations for the past several months in an attempt to resolve this matter. Efforts to reach a settlement have included, but were not limited to Alternate Dispute Resolution proceedings, conference calls, meetings and exchanges of relevant information.

On or about June 13, 2008, attorneys for Respondent and Complainant reached an agreement in principle dispositive of all matters asserted in the Administrative Complaint, including an appropriate penalty.

The Parties, thereafter expeditiously engaged in settlement discussions in order to finalize the language and terms of the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CA/FO"). On June 17, 2008 EPA verbally accepted the last few remaining changes which were included in the CA/FO by Respondent. On June 19, 2008, attorney for Respondent informed Complainant that his client had agreed to the final terms of the CA/FO.

On June 20, 2008, the process of finalizing the CA/FO and preparing the internal EPA concurrence package was initiated by attorney for Complainant.

Once the CA/FO and concurrence package are finalized, they will be placed into concurrence with the appropriate EPA officials in Region 2's San Juan and New York offices for review and concurrence. When concurrence is obtained, it will then be expeditiously delivered to Respondent for signature. Also, in order to file a duly executed CA/FO, the signature of the Regional

Administrator will be obtained. Once this process concludes, the fully executed CA/FO will be expeditiously filed. The Parties currently expect to file the fully executed CA/FO on or before July 23, 2008, thirty days from the date of this Status Report.

Therefore, the parties hereby respectfully ask this Honorable Judge for an extension to July 23, 2008 to file the fully executed CA/FO in this matter.

This Status Report and Motion was discussed with and reviewed by Patricio Martínez Lorenzo, Esq., counsel for Respondent, who agreed to its filing.

This Status Report has been filed today by the Complainant in order to comply with Judge Gunning's previous verbal Order for a Status Report by June 25, 2008.
