Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §22.16, Respondent, Tanner Industries, Inc. ("Tanner"), requests that the Presiding Officer grant a thirty (30) day extension of time for Respondent to file an Answer in this proceeding.

On October 15, 2010, Gregory Dain, EPA Region 1 legal counsel in this proceeding, stated during a meeting of the parties that EPA would not oppose this motion.

Respondent received the Complaint on September 22, 2010. Therefore, in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.15, Respondent's Answer to the Complaint must be filed within thirty (30) days of September 22 2010, or by October 22, 2010.
