

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved March 5, 2008 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates April 24, 2008. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for a final month, to May 24, 2008.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have developed the possibility of a settlement, but additional time is needed if a settlement is to be actually concluded. In a conference call on April 16, 2008 the parties agreed that the ADR process should be continued.

Accordingly, the undersigned will continue to work as a Neutral in this case and will file another report with the Chief Administrative Law Judge by May 24, 2008, unless otherwise directed by her.


