Dear Mr. Gray Sr.:

On July 30, 2012, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2012-0040, ordering the Heart Butte K-12 Schools School District (Respondent) to comply with various regulations issued by EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. section 300f et seq.

Our records indicate that the Respondent is in violation of the Order. Among other things, the Order included the following requirements (quoted from items 17 and 18 of the "Order" section on page 3 of the Order).

- Respondent shall monitor the residual disinfectant level in the distribution system at the same time and place it collects total coliform samples, as required by 40 C.F.R. §§ 141.132(c)(1). No later than 10 days after the end of each quarter, Respondent shall report residual disinfectant sample results to the EPA, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.134(c).
 - Respondent did not monitor the residual disinfectant level in the distribution system at the same time and place it collects total coliform samples in August and September 2012.
- 2. Respondent shall monitor the System's water monthly for total coliform bacteria and, if any sample is positive for total coliform, conduct repeat and additional routine monitoring, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.21. Respondent shall report analytical results to the EPA within the first 10 days following the month in which Respondent receives sample results, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(a). Respondent shall report any violation of coliform monitoring requirements in 40 C.F.R. part 141 to the EPA within 10 days after discovering the violation, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.21(g)(2).

Respondent had a positive total coliform sample on August 27, 2012 and failed to take repeats in a timely manner. Respondent did not report the violation to EPA within 10 days after discovering the violation.
