

**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF
ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS**

The Alternative Dispute Resolution (“ADR”) process currently expires on February 1, 2011. Complainant has filed a letter requesting an extension of the ADR process by 30 days. In its letter, Complainant indicates that the parties have reached a settlement in principle regarding the violations alleged in the Complaint. Complainant has drafted a Consent Agreement and Final Order (“CAFO”) that is currently under review by EPA Region 6 management. Complainant anticipates that an approved draft CAFO will be available for Respondent’s review and signature by February 14, 2011, and that a fully executed CAFO will be filed by February 28, 2011. For good cause having been shown, the time period provided for ADR is extended for 30 days or until March 3, 2011.
