REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Chief Administrative Law Judge's Order of August 22, 2006 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates October 23, 2006. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for another month, to November 23, 2006.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have developed the possibility of a settlement, but additional time is needed if a settlement is to be actually concluded.
