Dear Mayor Offe:

On September 27, 2012, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order (Order) ordering the Town of Hartville (Town), which was named as the Respondent in that Order, to bring its public water system (System) into compliance with various regulations promulgated pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water Act. The purpose of this letter is to correct an error in the Order regarding reporting of residual disinfectant sample results. The September 27, 2012, Order included the following requirement (item 17 on page 3 of the Order):

17. Respondent shall monitor the residual disinfectant level in the System's water in the distribution system at the same time and place it collects total coliform samples, as required by 40 C.F.R. §§ 141.132(c)(1) and 141.2. No later than 10 days after the end of each month, Respondent shall report residual disinfectant sample results required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.132(c)(1) to the EPA, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.134.

The requirement for reporting residual disinfectant sample results is quarterly, not monthly. Below is the correct language for this requirement (item 17 on page 3 of the Order):

17. Respondent shall monitor residual disinfectant level in the System's water in the distribution system at the same time and place it collects total coliform samples, as required by 40 C.F.R. §§ 141.132(c)(1) and 141.2. No later than 10 days after the end of each quarter, Respondent shall report residual disinfectant sample results required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.132(c)(1) to the EPA, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.134.


On October 10, 2012, EPA gave notification to Mr. James Weinkauff, Town Operator, regarding this change, however, with this letter we are providing written notice correcting the Order to require that results be reported only quarterly. Please be advised that the Town is required to comply with all provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
