Counsel for Complainant, EPA, and Respondent, Gilbert Agee, hereby jointly request an extension of time to allow the parties to complete the negotiation of a settlement of this matter.

By the end of alternative dispute resolution, the parties had come to agreement on a penalty that would resolve this matter and had agreed that part of the penalty would be paid in cash and the remainder would be offset by Respondent's completion of a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP). Over the last 30 days, the parties have discussed the details of a SEP proposed by Respondent that would improve water quality and enhance habitat within the watershed basin where the alleged violations had occurred. Because Respondent's proposed SEP is a part of a larger wetland enhancement project sponsored by the local soil and water conservation district, the parties required further detailed information from the local soil and water conservation district in order to accurately assess the value of the proposed SEP.

AGEE MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Complainant received detailed information describing the SEP last week and is currently calculating the credit that can be given for the SEP. After completing these calculations, further negotiations with Respondent will be needed to reach final settlement.

Therefore, the parties request that the time to file a CAFO be extended by 30 days to June 6, 2003, to allow the parties to reach final settlement of this matter.
