Dear Chairman Not Afraid, Jr. and Mr. Black Eagle,

The EPA has decided to close the Emergency Administrative Order (Order) regarding the public water system specified in the subject line. The EPA has determined that there are no remaining obligations under the Order. As detailed in the attached document, the Tribe has taken the appropriate steps to correct the issues that caused the pressure loss. Therefore, at this time, there is no need for the order to be amended to incorporate a plan for correcting these issues.

Please be aware that you are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties.
